Description

- 1. Prospective suppliers must be Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to R.A. 5183.
- 6. Pursuant to Section IV (G) of the Guidelines in Annex H, a Certificate of PhilGEPS Registration (Platinum Membership) shall be a mandatory eligibility requirement for this procurement project.
- 7. The negotiations shall focus on the project requirements and guidelines, in accordance with the procedures prescribed in Annex H for Negotiated Procurement Due to Two Failed Biddings.
